GIVE GENEROUSLY

The amount an individual or household pledges depends upon their circumstances and their assessment of how contributions to UUCH reflect their values. The UUA recommends a fair share pledge ranging from 2% to 10% of your annual household income. Here is a breakdown of a recent pledge distribution.

Mid-year pledges are also welcome, so that ministries may respond to unexpected needs that may arise and to replace unrealized pledges from members' changing circumstances.

We hold several Fundraising Events throughout the year. These events are a way to have fun and develop our beloved community while adding financial resources to the budget. The major event is our service auction held annually. Smaller events are a book sale and a rummage sale, usually held biennially. Occasionally we hold other special fundraising events, as needs and opportunities arise.
